Regular Meeting

March 8, 2013

The regular meeting of the Board of County Road Commissioners met on Friday, March 8, 2013 and called to order at 10:00 A.M. by Chairman Bird.

Present: Commissioners Bird, Elhart, Palarz, Grifhorst, Miedema, Manager Laughlin;

The Board reviewed and audited the vouchers for March 7, 2013.

Commissioner Palarz moved to approve the Agenda as presented, seconded by Commissioner Grifhorst and carried.

Commissioner Palarz moved to approve minutes of February 21, 2013, seconded by Commissioner Grifhorst and carried.

Commissioner Elhart moved to approve payment of bills in the amount of \$964,751.67, seconded by Commissioner Palarz and carried as shown by the following roll call vote:

Representatives of DFK, Inc. and Holland Engineering, Inc. joined the meeting to discuss a proposed extension of Greenway Drive in Greenway Corporate Park, Holland Township. After consideration and discussion, the following motions were made:

- Commissioner Palarz moved to deny the request as submitted. Motion died for lack of support.
- Commissioner Elhart moved to extend the cul-de-sac as proposed by DFK, Inc. Motion died for lack of support.
- Commissioner Grifhorst moved to allow a permanent cul-de-sac at the point of the existing temporary cul-de-sac. Motion died for lack of support.
- Commissioner Palarz moved to deny the request for an extension as submitted, supported by Commissioner Miedema. The Commissioner's withdrew the motion prior to vote.
- Commissioner Grifhorst moved to approve the request for an extension of Greenway Drive as submitted on the conceptual plan subject to receipt of 66' wide strip of land from the proposed permanent turnaround of Greenway Drive north to the property line that is to be warranty deeded to Ottawa County Road Commission and subject to staff review of final plans, seconded by Commissioner Elhart and carried.

Commissioner Elhart moved to approve the Baldwin Street from 20th Avenue to Cottonwood Drive construction plans as presented, seconded by Commissioner Grifhorst and carried.

Commissioner Elhart moved the adoption of the following resolution:

Whereas, the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Ottawa, by execution of this resolution, hereby consents to and authorizes the taking of the following action and waive any notice which may be required in connection herewith.

120th Avenue: Holland City Limits to RR Tracks (south of Lakewood) for FY2013 STP Funding 2 inch mill and resurface.

\$138,136 Federal Share

\$ 34,535 Local Match (Participating)

\$172,671 Total Participating Construction Costs

Riley Street: US-31 to Beeline for FY2013 STP Funding

2 inch mill and resurface.

\$137,474 Federal Share

\$ 34,369 Local Match

\$171,843 Total Participating Construction Costs
