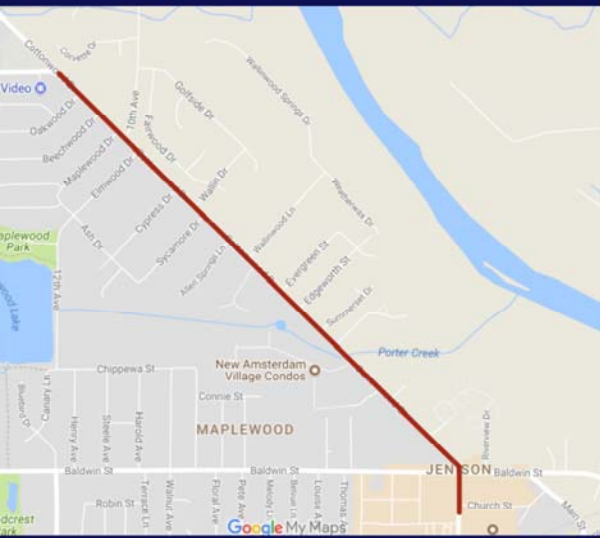




Cottonwood Drive Reconstruction



This project is partially funded by the Ottawa County Countywide Millage.



Anticipated Timeline

- Feb. 2018** ➔ Tree cutting begins Feb 12 in right-of-way, expected to be finished by March 23. Utility installation begins Feb. 5, expected to continue through the start of the reconstruction project.
- May 2018** ➔ Reconstruction of Cottonwood, sections north and south of Baldwin, begins in May.
- June 2018** ➔ Cottonwood, section south of Baldwin will finish in June. Section north of Baldwin will continue through October. The intersection of Cottonwood and Bauer will not be closed until after July 9.
- Oct. 2018** ➔ Planned Completion in the end of October.

These dates are anticipated and meant for public reference. As with all construction projects these dates are dependent on weather and other factors. Please check our website for the most up to date information

Expected Impacts:

- Lane Closures for tree removal.
- Periodic lane closures for utility installation.
- Road closures on Cottonwood, south of Baldwin and north of Baldwin.
- Closure of the Bauer and Cottonwood intersection during part of the project.
- Traffic will be maintained on Baldwin throughout the project.

Improvements Being Made:

- Cottonwood and Baldwin Intersection: The addition of a left turn lane, making two left turn lanes both north and southbound. The addition of a right turn lane going southbound.
- Widening of Cottonwood to five lanes, with a middle left turn lane the entire length.
- Georgetown Township will be installing watermain and sanitary forcemain as part of this project.
