<p>SUBJECT: INSTALLATION OF PAVEMENT CENTERLINE MARKINGS</p>	

I. Primary Roads

A. Centerline markings are to be installed on all paved roads.

II. Local Roads

A. Centerline markings are to be installed on all undivided pavements of three or more lanes.

B. Centerline markings are to be considered for paved roadways providing all the following conditions are met or other locations as determined by an engineering study.

1. Through roadways and section line roads excluding subdivision streets.
2. Pavement surface of 20 feet or greater in width and extending a minimum of 0.75 miles in length.
3. Speed limit greater than 35 MPH.

Adopted by the Board of County Road Commissioners: August 19, 2014

This policy supersedes and rescinds the previous Installation of Pavement Centerline Markings Policy of May 1, 1996.
