<p style="text-align: center;">SUBJECT: USE OF HANICAP, DEAF, BLIND, SPECIAL NEEDS CHILD, OR PEDESTRIAN AREA SIGNS</p>	

The use of Handicap, Deaf, Blind, Special Needs Child, or Pedestrian Area warning signs shall be limited to situations and locations meeting approval of the Ottawa County Road Commission. Request for such signs shall be made in writing and shall include physician's certification/letter indicating extent of handicap. Requesting party shall also agree to advise the Road Commission on an annual basis as to the continued need of these warning signs. The number and location of these warning signs will be determined by the Road Commission and generally will be limited to roadway serving handicap person's residence.

Cost of installation will be the responsibility of the requesting resident and all costs to maintain sign(s) will be paid by the Road Commission.

This policy supersedes and rescinds the previous Use of Handicap, Deaf, Blind, Special Needs Child or Pedestrian Area Signs Policy of April 10, 2008.
